



West Gippsland Healthcare Group provides a range of services including acute medical and surgical, obstetric, emergency, community health, allied health and aged care services.

It comprises a number of sites including the West Gippsland Hospital, Baw Baw Health and Community Care Centre, Community Services Centres in Warragul and Trafalgar, Cooinda Lodge Aged Care Residence, Rawson Community Health Centre, Andrews House Aged Care Residence and the Warragul Linen Service.

### West Gippsland Hospital

- Acute hospital (approx. 102 beds)
- 2 Operating Theatres (plans for third theatre underway)
- > 5 Birthing suites
- Plans for short stay unit in progress

- > 12,000+ inpatients each year (2016/17 annual report)
- > 22,000+ Emergency presentations annually
- > 909 births in 2017
